Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) application submitted by FCA US, LLC (FCA), to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). The application is requesting the installation of a new automotive paint shop and the modification of an existing automotive assembly line. The project is proposed to be located at the existing FCA Warren Truck Assembly Plant located at 21500 Mound Road, Warren, Michigan. The PTI application is identified as No. 13-19A.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period and public hearing on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The public comment period ended on August 19, 2019, and the public hearing was held on the same date to allow for verbal comments by interested parties. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received one (1) written comment during the public comment period and no verbal comments were presented at the public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI No. 13-19A with modifications made to the proposed permits.

The Response to Comments Document (RTC) provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. It also identifies special conditions which have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. The changes are listed in Sections II and III of the RTC.
